When the team *ar* is preceded by the sound /w/, *ar* usually makes the /or/ sound and is double underlined to indicate the second sound the team *ar* represents: warm.

When the team *or* is preceded by the sound /w/, *or* usually makes the /er/ sound and is double underlined to indicate the second sound the team *or* represents: work.

The letter team *ea* makes the sound *ay* in three words: *break*, *great*, and *steak*. Mark these words by underlining *ea* and placing an *x* directly under the *ea* team. An *x* written under a letter or letter team indicates that the letter or letter team is representing a sound different from the sound it normally represents:
break, great, steak.
