We are pleased to offer live online tutoring on Skype. We offer a blended instructional model for those who would like to combine the convenience and economy of an online subscription with the guidance and personal interaction of private instruction. Of course, our online program is designed so that everything you need to learn to read and and spell is available online. But some people prefer receiving personal instruction in addition to the online lessons.

To login, go to our homepage at www.weallcanread.com. Scroll down to the blue box and enter your new user name and password and then click *Enter*. You then will be redirected to the online lessons beginning with Lesson 29. On this page you will find all of the remaining lessons. You will always login by entering your user name and password in the blue box. (The first 28 lessons are free for anyone to access from our homepage.)

At some point you will want to access the master answer key for the quizzes we have in the program. We have 165 quizzes embedded in the online program. The link to the answer key document is located at the top of this same page referred to in the above paragraph where Lesson 29 through Lesson 644 are located. This is the page you are redirected to upon entering your user name and password. Select the indicated link to download all of the answer keys for all 165 quizzes. **This answer key document is password protected. Ask your program administrator for the password or consult the confirmation letter you received upon registering for the online subscription. Please note the password is not the same password you will use to login to the online program.**

If you are a teacher, tutor, or parent, then please read the document titled *Sequence of Lessons Teachers/Tutors/Parents Select for Students*. The link to this document is located just under the link to the answer key document on the same page containing Lesson 29 to Lesson 644. **Certain lessons are not appropriate for students beyond the fifth grade, and this document tells you the order of lessons to use with middle and high school students and adults.**

If you are a student working independently, then please read the document titled

Sequence of Lessons Adults Select When Working Independently. The link to this document is located on the same page containing Lesson 29 to Lesson 644. **Certain lessons are not appropriate for adults to use, and this document tells you the order of lessons to select.**

Finally there is another link titled *Personal Progress Chart*. This chart provides a checklist of activities that the student completes in each lesson. Use this chart to track your own progress or the progress of students as they proceed through all 644 lessons contained in our online program.
